Catherine Parr (sometimes alternatively spelled Katherine, Katheryn or Katharine) (1512 () – 7 September 1548 ()) was Queen of England and Ireland (1543–47) as the last of the six wives of King Henry VIII, and the final queen consort of the House of Tudor. She married him on 12 July 1543, and outlived him by one year. With four husbands she is the most-married English queen.
