The gains from rebellion are thus an increasing function of both $p(T) \cdot T$ and P . We now turn to the costs of rebellion. First, the actual conduct of civil war is costly to the rebels. This is due partly to the opportunity cost of rebel labour and partly to the disruption to economic activity caused by warfare.

3.1 Definition of Civil War. The study of the causes of civil war requires a definition of civil war. Civil war is a poorly observed phenomenon because it is often difficult to determine the start, end and intensity of deadly conflict.
