The peripheral nervous system is further divided into the somatic system and the autonomic system. The somatic system consists of sensory receptors in the head and extremities, nerves that carry sensory information to the central nervous system, and nerves that carry instructions from the central nervous system to the skeletal muscles.

The nervous system has two parts. The central nervous system (CNS) is the control center. It includes the brain and spinal cord. It gets information from the senses, figures out what to do, and sends back instructions. Messages travel to and from the brain to parts of the body along neurons. Neurons are grouped in long fibers called nerves.
