Cerebral ischemia occurs when blood flow to the brain is insufficient to meet metabolic demand. This can result from cerebral artery occlusion that interrupts blood flow, limits CNS supply of oxygen and glucose, and causes an infarction/ischemic stroke.

Drug delivery to the ischemic brain. - Pharmacology

Ischemic stroke is caused by focal cerebral ischemia due to arterial occlusion [1,4,9,10,14] or stenosis [17] whereas hemorrhagic stroke occurs when a blood vessel in the brain bursts, spilling blood into the spaces surrounding the brain cells or when a cerebral aneurysm ruptures[18].



The Science of Ischemic Stroke: Pathophysiology

A ischemic stroke (IS) is caused by the transient or permanent disruption of the Cerebral Blood Flow (CBF) to a single or several brain areas, during 24h, due to the blockade of a vessel .
