A medical ventilator (or simply ventilator in context) is a machine designed to provide mechanical ventilation by moving breathable air into and out of the lungs, to deliver breaths to a patient who is physically unable to breathe, or breathing insufficiently.. While modern ventilators are computerized machines, patients can be ventilated with a simple, hand-operated bag valve mask.
