The ventilator is alarming due to high pressures. The patient's current vitals are HR 140, BP 80/50, SpO2 82%. The ventilator settings are VCV rate 12, tidal volume 450, PEEP 15, FiO2 100%.

Abstract. Patient-ventilator asynchrony exists when the phases of breath delivered by the ventilator do not match those of the patient.
